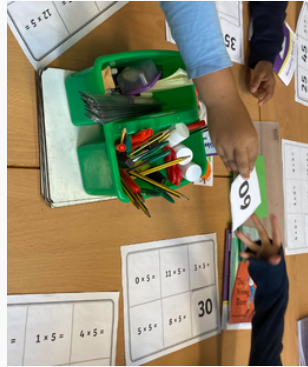

We are now nearly 4 weeks into the new school year. Our teachers are using all of the information on how children have settled in to the new school year and last year's data/teacher handovers to ensure we are focusing on children's learning priorities - from early morning times table/number bonds practice to 1:1 reading, we are giving children what they most need to make great progress.

One of our three school improvement priorities this year will focus on developing our children's voice. We'll do this with their spoken communication skills (oracy) and in their written communication skills. In a rapidly changing world, our children will benefit more than ever with being confident communicators who can clearly express their thoughts, feelings and needs to others.
