WELCOME BACK TO OUR READING BREAKFAST....



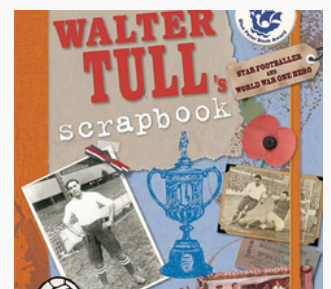
