Year 6 SATs tests

Next week our year 6 children have their SATs tests. These are National assessments which determine if children are meeting the end of KS2 standards or are not yet meeting them.

We always aim to ensure that children do not see these as high-stakes tests. They are simply a tool to identify where children may need more support as they move onto Secondary school and the KS3 curriculum. They are also one of the tools used to check our performance as a school.

Our year 6's will be joining us for a special SATs breakfast next week to support them with feeling relaxed and spending time socially with teachers and classmates. We have reminded children that it is sensible that they are getting good night's sleep and are being mindful of screentime: these are important habits to build now. Thank you to our families for supporting these messages.
