A huge well done to our Y6 children for their hard work and positive attitude towards this week's SATs tests. They have done themselves and their families proud.



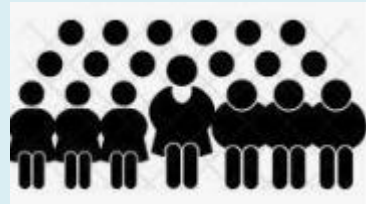
