STAYING SAFE TRAVELLING TO/FROM SCHOOL

Coborn Street is a 'school street' this means limited cars should be travelling down the road at the start/end of the day. There are important exceptions: local residents and those with a permit. If children are on a bike/scooter it is really important they are safe as many are too small to be seen over a car's bonnet. If at all possible, avoid children being on the road. If not, help children be very mindful about their road positioning to be safe.

Please also check your child has a helmet: if there is an accident it provides some protection.
