

## English

Our topic will continue the theme of exploring Egypt with Marcy and the riddle of the Sphinx, before turning to looking at the Stone Age Boy.

Our outcomes will be rewriting part of a story in a first person account and continuing to our non chronological report writing skills. In grammar we will focus on: conjunctions, past tense and the use of the apostrophe.

## DT

Our topic will be Ancient Egyptian collars. In this unit, we will be investigating their original purpose, designing our own and using applique skills to create modern versions. Finally, we will be evaluating our outcomes.

## History

We will be learning about the changes from Stone **Age to Iron Age in Britain**. Along the way, we will study the amazing **Skara Brae** settlement. As historians, we will be investigating why it is difficult to work out why **Stone-henge** was built and using our historical detective skills to try to solve the mystery of the 52 bodies of Maiden Castle.

## Maths

In **multiplication and division**, we will be using arrays to solve problems, solving column multiplication and using flexible partitioning. We will also be investigating the relationship between multiplication and division. In **money** we will be converting pounds and pence, and add and subtract money.

When working on **statistics**, we will be reading and making our own pictograms and bar graphs.

## PSHE

We will be continuing to provide opportunities for our children to develop healthy attitudes to conflict, resolution and improve their self esteem. Our classes will look at the theme of Dreams and Goals through collaboration.

## PE

Our classes will be performing gymnastic pieces in unison. We will be learning basketball skills as part of the invasion games series. As part of the games series, children will be learning to improve their tag rugby and football skills but also how to play, win and lose competitive sports. We will also be using opportunities to self improve and self reflect on our own performances.

## Science

In science we will be learning about **Light and Shadows**. Recognising the need for light, reflections, shadows, protecting your eyes from the Sun and prepare for later learning on its movements.

## Computing

Our online safety continues with lessons about password protection and not sharing data and online communication. Our focus is how to use online searches to produce an article about events which happened on the date of their birth. On the way, we will be learning how to search safely and effectively by being critical of searches, identifying which one is the most useful.

## French

As part of our Modern Foreign Language provision, our classes will be continuing French through the topic of Instruments.

## Art

In art lessons we will be looking at '**Working with Colour and Shape**.' The focus is creation of art through collages and the relationship between positive and negative spaces created when cutting shapes.
