

## Maths

- In Maths this term, Year 1 will be developing their understanding of multiplication by making equal groups and practising counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Children will also explore fractions, learning to recognise and find halves and quarters of shapes and small quantities.
- Later in the term, pupils will learn about position and direction, using language such as left, right, forwards and backwards to describe movement and turns.

## History

In History, Year 1 will be learning about the [Great Fire of London](#).

Children will use a timeline to understand when the event happened and what took place during the fire.

They will explore artefacts, primary and secondary sources to learn how we know about the past.

Pupils will also look at how houses and firefighting have changed over time, comparing the past with how fires are put out today.

## PE

**In this unit, children will explore running. By the end of this unit, children will learn to:**

Explore different ways of running. Can pupils run in different directions? (Forwards, backwards and sideways.) Can pupils run at different speeds? (fast and slow.) Can pupils run using different parts of their feet (Heel, balls, sole and toes). Think about 'How does running on different parts of our feet effect how fast we can run?'

## English

In English we are going to continue focusing on our targets. Children must use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Children should use joining words to enhance a simple sentence.

### Science

In this module, children will learn to:

- observe changes across the four seasons
- observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.



## Art

### Playful making

In this unit children are introduced to what sculpture can be, and invited to explore the work of other sculptors whilst taking a playful and inventive approach to making their own sculptures.

Children will be encouraged to start voicing their response to sculptural artworks, including their own, and to give them time and space to explore properties of materials, and what happens when you join one or more materials together to construct new forms.

## PSHE

In PSHE, Year 1 will be learning about relationships, focusing on how to be a good friend, show kindness and respect, and work well with others.

Children will talk about different types of relationships, including family and friends, and how to solve simple problems together.

## Computing

In Computing, children will use ScratchJr to create simple programs and will learn about staying safe when using the internet.
