Hopefully this will be an improved offer for families. More information on this move will follow shortly..



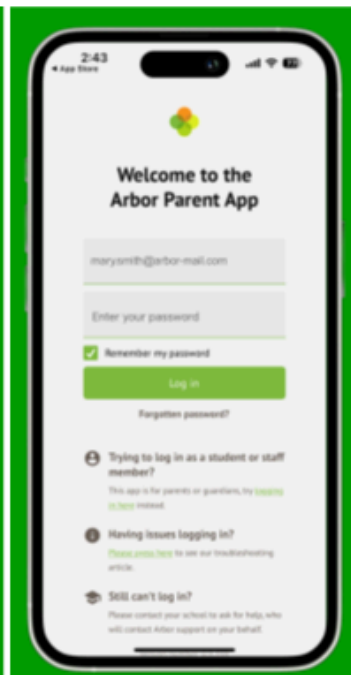
