FIDGET TOOLS

We have a few children who use fidget tools to support with self-regulating and maintaining focus during learning.

These are provided by our SENCO's (Glynis and Rebecca), in discussion with parents. Our usual practice is to avoid children bringing in toys from home and to instead provide a school-based learning aid.

In school, we talk about 'fidget tools' not fidget toys - children are trained how best to use them to support with learning/regulation and how to avoid distracting others. We regularly review how effective these are in supporting each child.
